



Volunteer Opportunities

Thanks for your interest! Each and every person that volunteers is greatly appreciated by River Music Experience, and we could not do any of the events without help. Here is a brief description of some volunteering opportunities we have available:

Street Team

Become a member of our “Street Team” and help the RME distribute posters and flyers around town at other local businesses and events. You can log as many or as little hours on this team as you’d like and set your own schedule, but the more hours you distribute the faster you earn free tickets to our upcoming performances and events!

Redstone Room Greeter Program

Sign up to be a “Greeter” before the music begins at our Redstone Room concerts and chat up the patrons who arrive early by telling them what great programs and events the RME has to offer, solicit memberships, gain new emails for our newsletter, and overall just talk about the RME! Brief training (10-15 minutes) is required before your first shift and then each show is only one hour from the time the doors open until the music begins to work the volunteering shift. Once your shift is over you can stay at the concert for free!

Special Events

We solicit many of our volunteers to assist the RME Team in helping execute some of our special events throughout the year, including our annual fundraisers, the Winter Wine Experience (in January) and BeeRME for Music (in June), as well as our summer concert series, Friday Live @5 (every Friday, June – September). Volunteers in this area might also be presented with the option of working other community events at an RME Booth/Information table as needed. Shifts may include assisting with admissions/greeting, selling memberships, working the raffle table(s) and set-up and tear-down assistance. Shifts typically last one hour, but you may sign up for more if you'd like!

Maintenance/Special Projects

Are you literally more of a “hands on” volunteer? Then ask to be included for opportunities to help the RME with building maintenance, flood prevention & clean-up (seasonal), and special projects that require an assembly team. Sometimes we just need help fixing some tables and chairs, and other times we may ask help to paint walls, build structures, clean & organize spaces and anything else that may require some TLC!
